STATEMENT REGARDING CELEBRATIONS OF FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION FROM THE BISHOP DENIS NULTY.

I know there is concern around celebrating the sacraments of First Holy Communion & Confirmation. The government guideline about the return to public worship specifically advises that "other religious ceremonies such as Communions and Confirmations should not take place at this time" I know that this is disappointing news.

As you know I had already asked parishes not to plan to celebrate these sacraments in May this year. I am, however, aware that many parishes were hoping, and indeed planning, to offer dates for Confirmation and First Holy Communion to parents for the month of June, as soon as the return to public worship had been allowed. Given the latest advice from the Government I am now asking that parishes do not proceed with planning for June and do not set any dates until further clarity is offered.

Reopening of Churches for Public Worship

We can have people back to Mass from Tuesday10th May. We are allowed pods of fifty depending on the size of the Church. We can have two pods of fifty in our Church.
