

A Blessing for the Home on the **Feast of St Brigid**

May Brigid bless this house wherein we dwell. Bless every fireside, every wall and door. Bless every heart that beats beneath its roof.

Bless every hand that toils to bring it joy. Bless every foot that walks its portals through. May Brigid bless this house

That shelters me and you.

Blessing of the throat will take place at Mass

St. Blaise

St. Blaise was born in Sebastea, Turkey. He preached Christianity in his home town and was known as a healer.

He became famous for performing certain miracles such as helping the sick animals and people around his home town.

He is recognised as the patron saint of throat disease or "The Blessing of the Throats".

His Feast Day is the 3rd of February. He is also the Patron Saint of wool combers, animals and wool trading and is considered as one of the "Holy Helpers" of which there are only fourteen. These helpers were called upon to help during the time of plague in the hope they'd cure those

that were ill. His most famous and memorable act was when he healed a young boy that chocked on a fishbone. The boy was placed at the Saints feet by his mother and he healed straight away. Crossed candles are an important

part of Saint Blaise Day, they commemorate the mother of the boy who chocked on the fishbone. She presented Saint Blaise with crossed candles to light his way to jail when the ruler of Sebastea ordered his arrest when he would not renounce his faith. The origin of the blessing of throats uses crossed candles as a symbol.

Prayer in Honour of St. Blaise

O GOD, deliver us through the intercession of Thy holy bishop and martyr Blaise, from all evil of soul and body, especially from all ills of the throat; and grant us the grace to make a good confession in the confident hope of obtaining Thy pardon, and ever to praise with worthy lips Thy most holy name.
