SAINTS

12th November

St Josaphat, 1580-1623, Bishop pf Polotz, worked for the reunion of Ukranian Catholics but was murdered.

14th November

St. Laurence O'Toole, 1123-1180, studied at Glendalough, became a monk and later its abbot. He became Archbishop of Dublin. He worked for peace and reconciliation and died on a mission of mediation with King Henry II with Irish leaders in

15th November

St. Albert the Great, 1206-1280, Dominican theologian, taught in Cologne. Patron of scientists.

St. Gertrude, 1256-1302, Benedictine nun, devoted to the Sacred Heart and advocated frequent

St. Elizabeth of Hungary, 1207-31, queen at fourteen, widowed and exiled at twenty, Franciscan tertiary until her death at twenty-four. A woman of prayer and service of the poor.
