agreed on the last day of the month long
assembly. In the coming months this report

Ireland and across the world, ahead of the
second part of the Assembly in October

SAINTS

12th November

St Josaphat, 1580-1623, Bishop of Polotsk, worked for
the reunion of Ukranian Catholics but was murdered.

14th November

St. Laurence O'Toole, 1123-1180, studied at Glen-
dalough, became a monk and later its abbot. He
became Archbishop of Dublin. He worked for peace
and reconciliation and died on a mission of
mediation with King Henry II with Irish leaders in
Normandy.

15th November

St. Albert the Great, 1206-1280, Dominican
theologian, taught in Cologne. Patron of scientists.

16th November

St. Gertrude, 1256-1302, Benedictine nun, devoted
to the Sacred Heart and advocated frequent
Communion.

St. Elizabeth of Hungary, 1207-31, queen at
fourteen, widowed and exiled at twenty, Franciscan
tertiary until her death at twenty-four. A woman of
prayer and service of the poor.
