



# CONCLUDING RITE

The message of Jesus can reach all people - through his Church and the Gospel, love and justice can spread to all peoples.





God is love, St. John tells us. If God were one person, then God's love would be focused on him/herself. God would find happiness and fulfilment in loving him/herself. But God is three persons, united in love. God is the love that exists

between Father, Son and Holy Spirit. God's happiness then arises from that love for each other. But even loving each other was not sufficient for the Trinity. We were created because the Trinity's love overflowed to include us in that love. We have been caught up, as it were, into that love. The wellknown Indian Jesuit mystic tells of the fish who asked another fish, "Where can I find this thing they call the ocean?" And the other fish answered "You are swimming in it." We are swimming in the ocean of God's love, but, like the fish, we are usually unaware of it. If God were one person, then since we are made in the image and likeness of God, we too would find happiness in loving ourselves, a selfish turning inwards on ourselves, without any concern for anyone else. But as every parent knows, and every child growing up in a loving, caring family, knows, our happiness is to be found in loving others. Two teenagers, madly in love, standing in a corner, locked in an embrace that they wish would never end, would not swap that moment for all the play-stations in the world! Because God is three persons in one being, our happiness and fulfilment can only be found in loving each other.
